Overview:

Our Contract was to Design and Build a new 7000m² Garden Centre on land adjacent to an existing, much smaller Garden Centre.

Scope of Works:

The scope included the site clearance, cut and fill, car parks, services, drainage, foundations, floor slabs, steel frame, wall and roof cladding including Polycarbonate panels.

The project also required an overhead HV diversion and a new sub-station, air source heating system, PV panels and new section S278 entrance junction, together with boundary fencing and lighting.

The co-ordination with the adjacent trading Garden Centre, an Indian restaurant and a petrol station was paramount to the build. This fast-track programme saw the store ready for fit out in 8 months. The full handover of the new store was completed within 12 months.
