OVERVIEW:

This project comprised of the groundworks and infrastructure for a new 97-unit housing development at Catteshall Lane in Godalming.

SCOPE OF WORKS:

This project was particularly challenging with a 10m fall across the site.

As well as this, the site was contaminated with a mixture of metals, asbestos, hydrocarbon, peat, solvents and a number of aquifers. All of these required over pumping.

We successfully managed the initial decontamination phase and the installation of retaining walls to the secondary and main roads as well as drainage. Now it is complete, the site will revert to a normal housing groundworks site.

We were selected for this project due to our historical expertise in remediation. Because of this experience, we were willing to take on the site risk.
