OVERVIEW:

This project involved the redevelopment of an unused farm shed, transforming it into 3 spacious and modern, barn style houses. In addition, we carried out the full construction of two new-builds.

SCOPE OF WORKS:

The scope of work for this development included the complete demolition of the existing structures, undertaking the groundworks to prepare the site, and the full construction of 2 residential units. Additionally, we then re-constructed a dilapidated barn and ensured that we preserved its character and refurbished the existing stone barn.

The completed development consists of 5 properties; 3 fourbedroom houses, 1 two-bedroom house and 1 three-bedroom house. The finished design incorporates the existing slate, brick/flint and timber boarding. These were complemented by the addition of modern glazing and high-quality, luxurious internal fittings.

Each property has a private garden and they have access to a shared area for refuse and recycling storage. There is a private courtyard for parking with at least two parking spaces per property and the facility for EV charging.

All of the properties have been finished to a high standard. These unique properties offer breathtaking and expansive views of the surrounding countryside.
