## OVERVIEW:

Natta was appointed to deliver the full infrastructure package required to enable the development of a new crematorium facility to serve Maldon and the surrounding areas. Appointed by Elegy and Maldon Fields, this phase of works was essential in preparing the site for the construction of the crematorium building and its associated amenities.

## SCOPE OF WORKS:

Our scope included the construction of a new S278 access bellmouth, providing safe and direct entry to the site from the public road. The team delivered the works in compliance with local authority standards, therefore ensuring long-term durability and road safety. Within the site boundary, Natta also constructed a new access road and car park to facilitate efficient traffic movement and provide adequate parking capacity for visitors and staff. Additionally, these elements were built to accommodate ceremonial vehicles and the larger traffic volumes typically associated with such facilities.

Substructure works included the formation of reinforced concrete foundations for the new crematorium building and separate plant building. The project also encompassed comprehensive drainage works, and Natta were responsible for the installation of surface water drainage systems to manage runoff and prevent flooding. In addition, we completed significant earthworks to prepare and level the site. As well as this, additional responsibilities included BWIC, street lighting installations, as well as the coordination of works to integrate seamlessly with the crematorium construction.

This project demonstrates Natta's expertise in delivering infrastructure schemes required for critical community facilities. Furthermore, our ability to manage live interfaces, and maintain quality and safety standards have ensured successful delivery on time and to specification. Overall the works have been delivered efficiently, on programme, and therefore fully in line with the client's expectations.
